Dear Parents and Carers of Year 5 children

We are writing to invite your child to attend the Y6 residential from Monday 26 January 2026 to Wednesday 28 January 2026 at Robinwood Maes-y-Nant Activity Centre, Wrexham. This is an opportunity for you children to take part in outdoor adventurous activities.

The cost of the trip will be £169, payable in instalments. Due to the cost of the trip, we would like to give you as much notice as possible. The cost of the trip covers accommodation at Maes-y-Nant, all meals and activities. The children will not need any spending money whilst on their trip.

We have devised a payment plan of £30.00 installments and the full amount must be paid in full by Friday 12 December 2025.

Money for the trip to be paid by either cash or cheque via the school office in the first instance. We are moving to an electronic payment system for September and further details about this will be sent when available.

We would like as many children as possible to take part in the residential. If you have not completed the permission form and paid the deposit by 13/06/25, it is unlikely that your child will be able to attend.

Throughout Y6, high standards of behaviour are expected. If a child does not display high levels consistently throughout the year, your child may not be able to attend the trip.

The children will work in teams over the three days at the Robinwood Centre and will be supervised by staff from St John's and highly trained staff from Maes-y-Nant. The purpose of the trip is to offer the children the opportunity to:

- work collaboratively in an out of school setting
- experience new adventurous activities and develop team work skills
- develop leadership skills
- create memories for life
- have fun!
