St John's Waterloo PTFA would like to challenge you to try to raise £26 over the summer holiday. How you do this is up to you!

Over the summer we would like to challenge as many children as possible to attempt to **raise £26 for the PTFA**. You can do anything you like to raise money in a fun, challenging or innovative way. You might like to base it around the **number 26**. This could be done as a **sponsored event, making & selling things or earning doing jobs**. It's up to you! You don't have to do this alone; you can join up with your friends or family and do this as a team effort. Use your imagination; the choice is yours.

£26 is the target but there is no minimum amount to raise and obviously we would love more if you managed it. **Everyone who takes part will get a medal. There will be prizes for the top fundraisers too.**

A trophy will be awarded to the class that raises the most money & they will get a whole class reward. The class who are leaving year 6 have been the top fundraisers for all 5 years in a row but it was close with the current year 5 and we have to have a new winner this year!

The Summer 25 Challenge paid for the inspirational visit from Steel from Gladiators, which all the children enjoyed. Funds raised previously have been spent on the two colourful Buddy Benches as well as the three playground tables & benches. This year's funds will go towards building an area in the playground with plans for gardening, seating and shade with reflection and sensory aspects to help with the mental health and wellbeing of all the children.
